

Dear Parents,

The WHO (World Health Organization <http://www.who.int/en/>) has raised the Influenza pandemic alert from phase 4 to 5. There are couple of tested positive cases in the Santa Clara County, including students. Some schools were closed. Further information is available on the Santa Clara County Health Department website at http://www.sccgov.org/swine_flu_update.html.

The Board of WVCLS has been closely monitoring the situation. As of today, we have NO plan to cancel any class. We still have school this Friday (5/1). We will update you, by every means, if the development leads to any change of the decision. Any emergency news will be posted on our school website (<http://ww.wvcls.org>).

In the meantime, WVCLS will keep in touch with Homestead High School as we shared the same facility. If HHS decides to shutdown the school, we will cancel our class. HOWEVER, we haven't heard any news regarding this from HHS yet.

Here, the Board strongly advise you and your child(ren):

1. Read the attached public notice in detail regarding this Flu and follow the instructions provided.
2. If you feel sick, or you think you have contacted any infected person / environment, please seek medical advice as soon as possible. Also, please stay home until you are advised by your doctor.
3. If your child(ren)'s day school has decided to shutdown due to the flu, please be advised to stay at home as well.
4. Please talk to your child(ren) maintaining personal hygiene at all times. If s/he feels uncomfortable during class, please ask him/her to report to the teacher at once.
